VALUES STATEMENT

WE believe each person:

- 1. Is a person first
- 2. Has personal preferences and interests to be safeguarded
- 3. Is entitled to be treated with equality and dignity, respecting his/her rights, needs and feelings
- 4. Is entitled to freedoms, rights, responsibilities and access
- 5. Is entitled to good health, medical and dental care
- 6. Is entitled to experience a normal level of exposure to a reasonable level of risk
- 7. Has the right to self-determination and support necessary to learn to make choices for his/her life
- 8. Has the right to a supportive network of personal relationships with family, friends, advocates and acquaintances
- 9. Has the right to live and work in a least restrictive environment; leading and/or participating in the decision making process
- 10. Has the right to live, work and participate in all aspects of community life acquiring interdependent and interconnecting relationships
- 11. Should be supported in and taught strategies to be their own self advocate
- 12. Has the right to expect that service providers will provide accountability of individualized care
