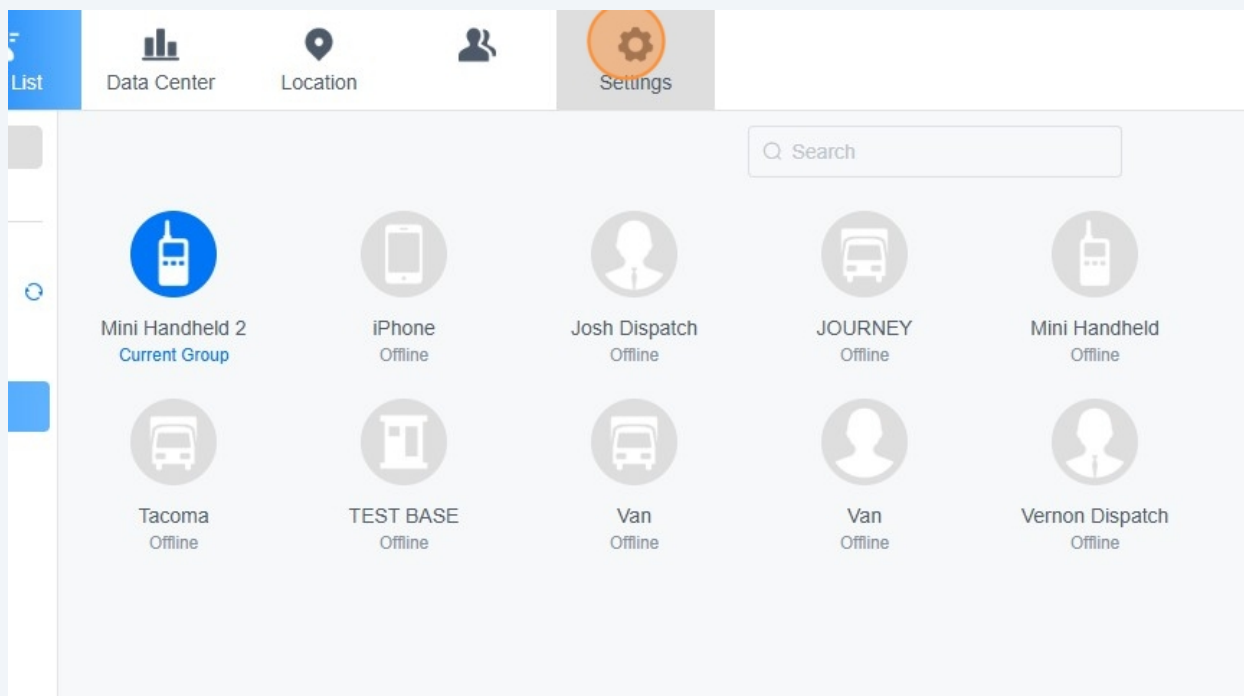

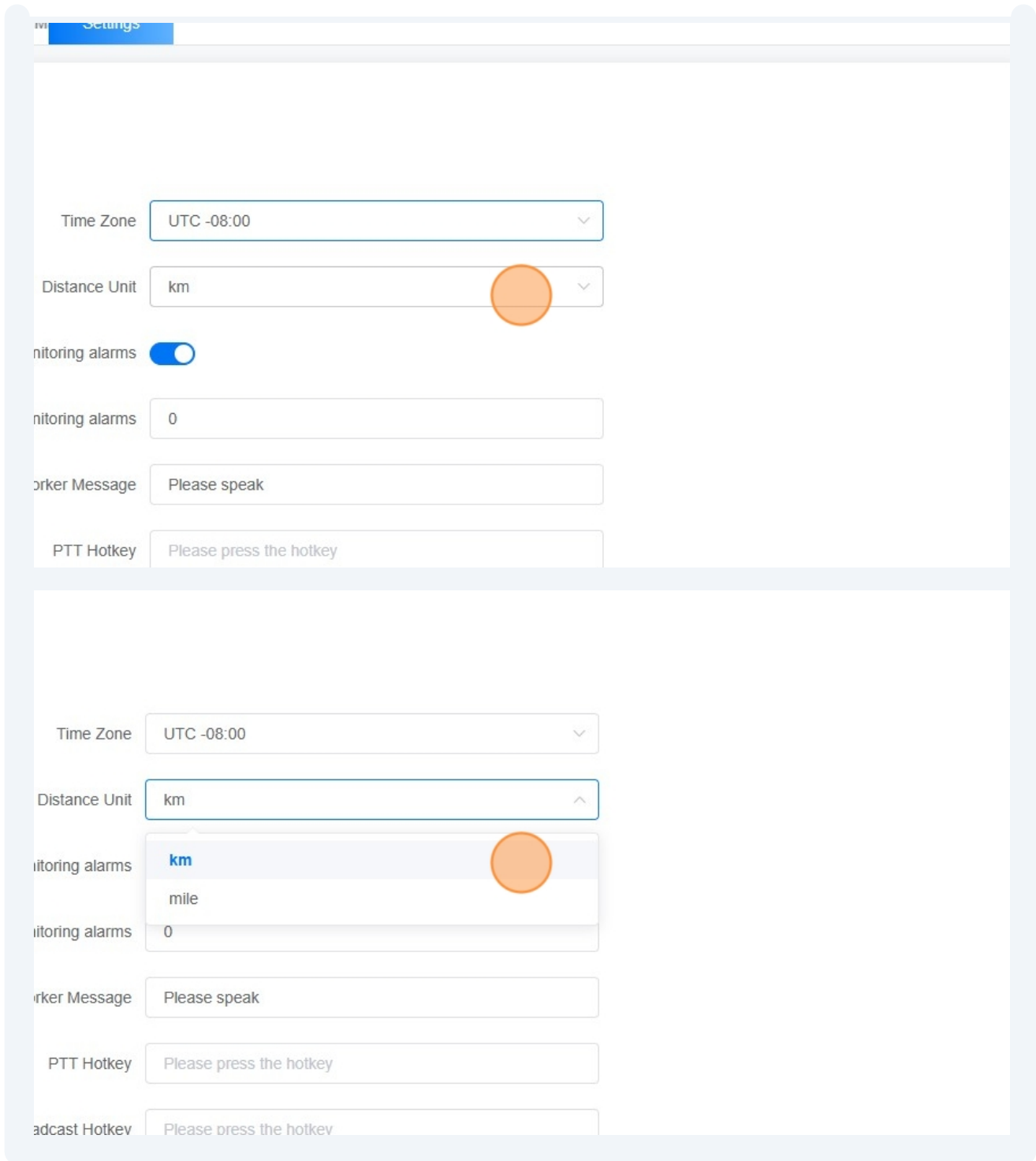

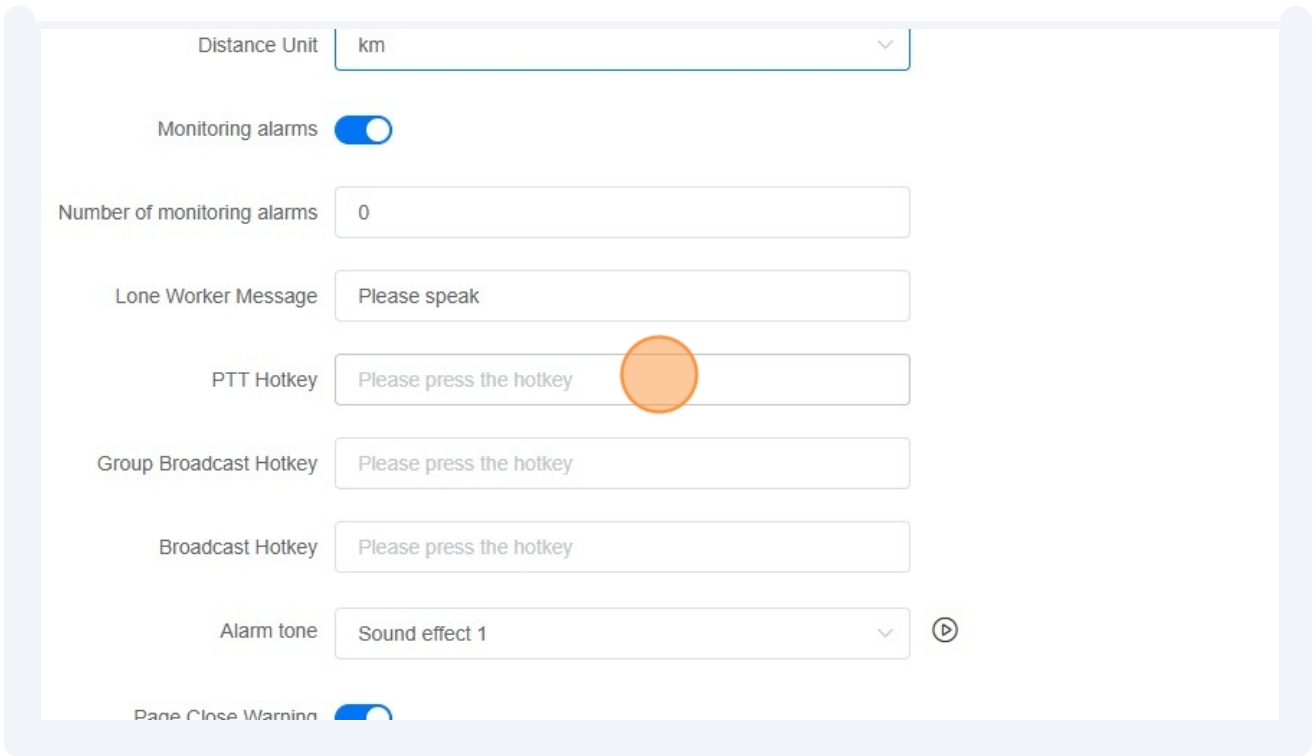

3 Click the "Please select a distance unit" field. Select your preference of KM or Miles.

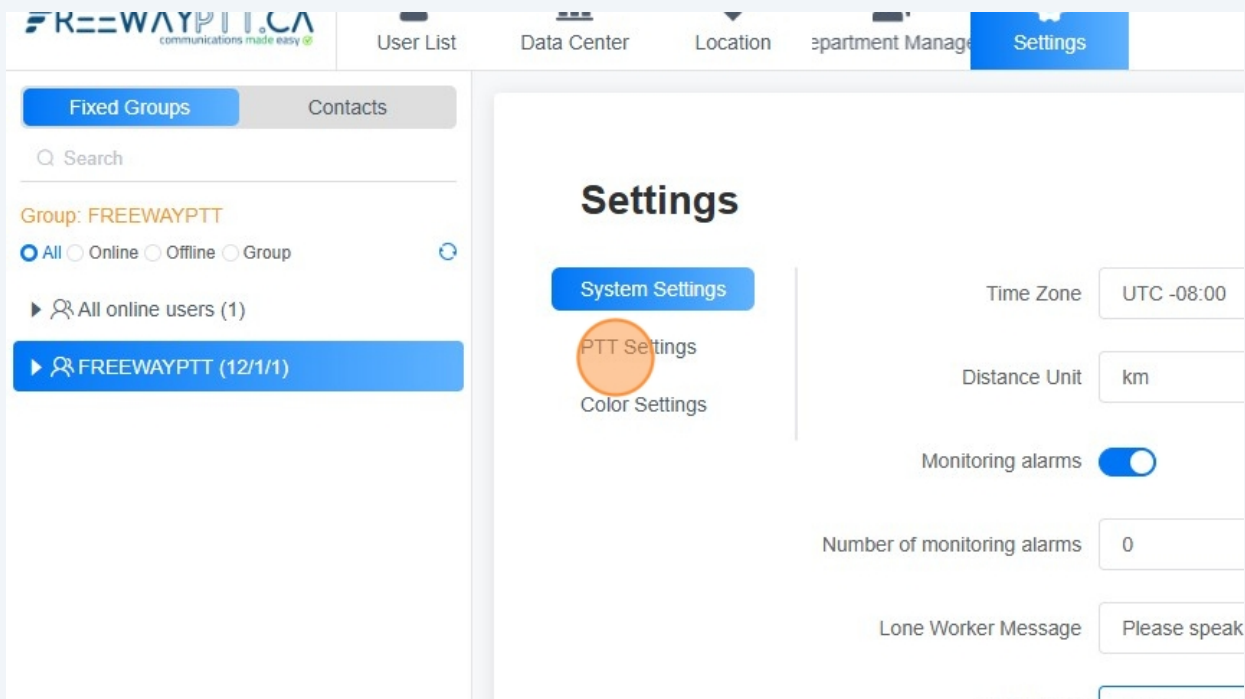


- 4 If you want to setup a shortcut transmit key for your radios on your keyboard
