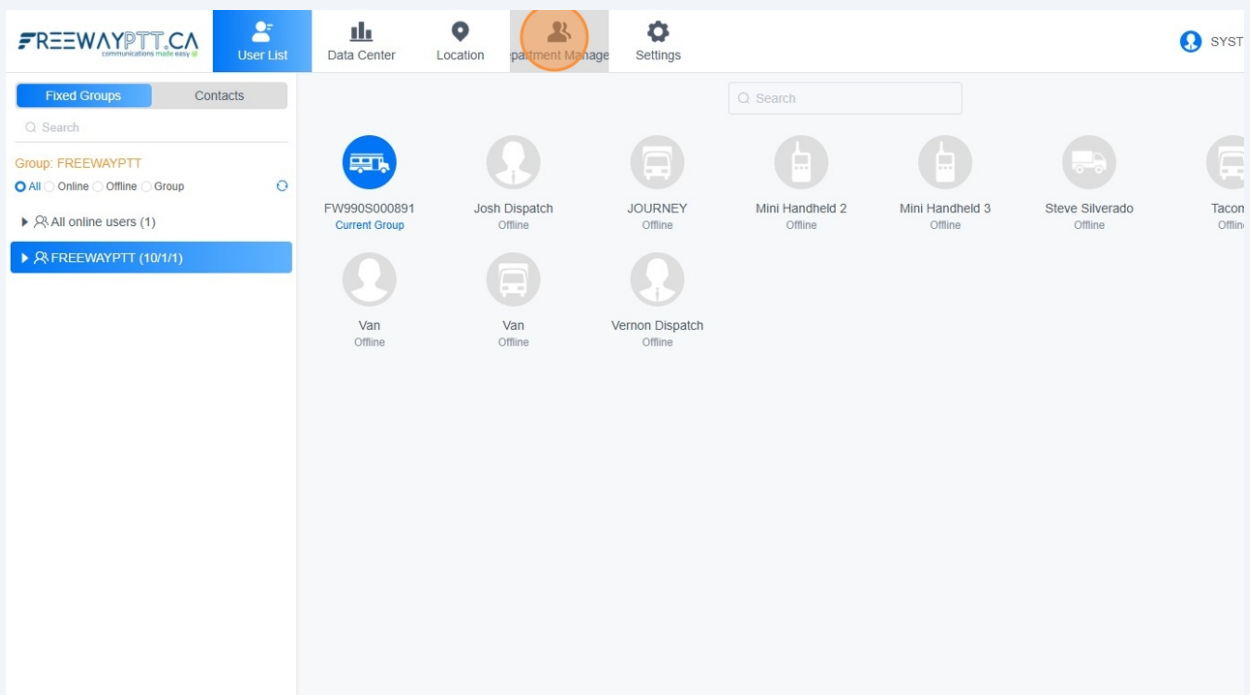


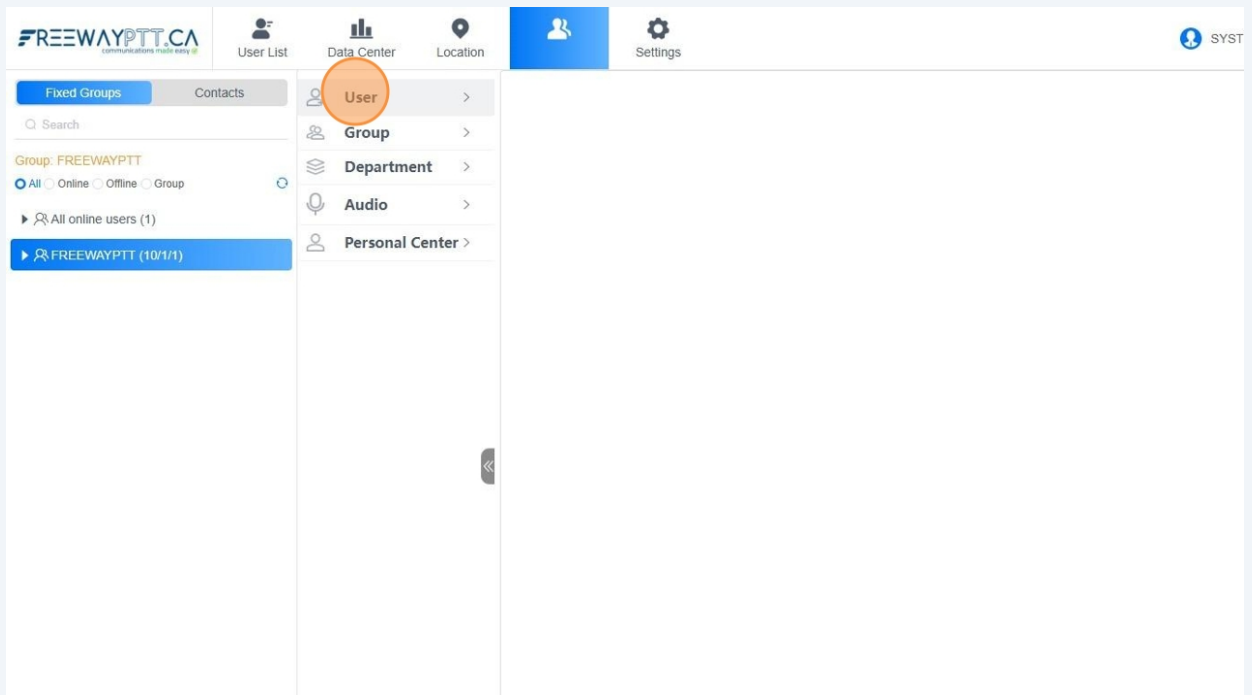
Managing User Groups in Freeway PTT

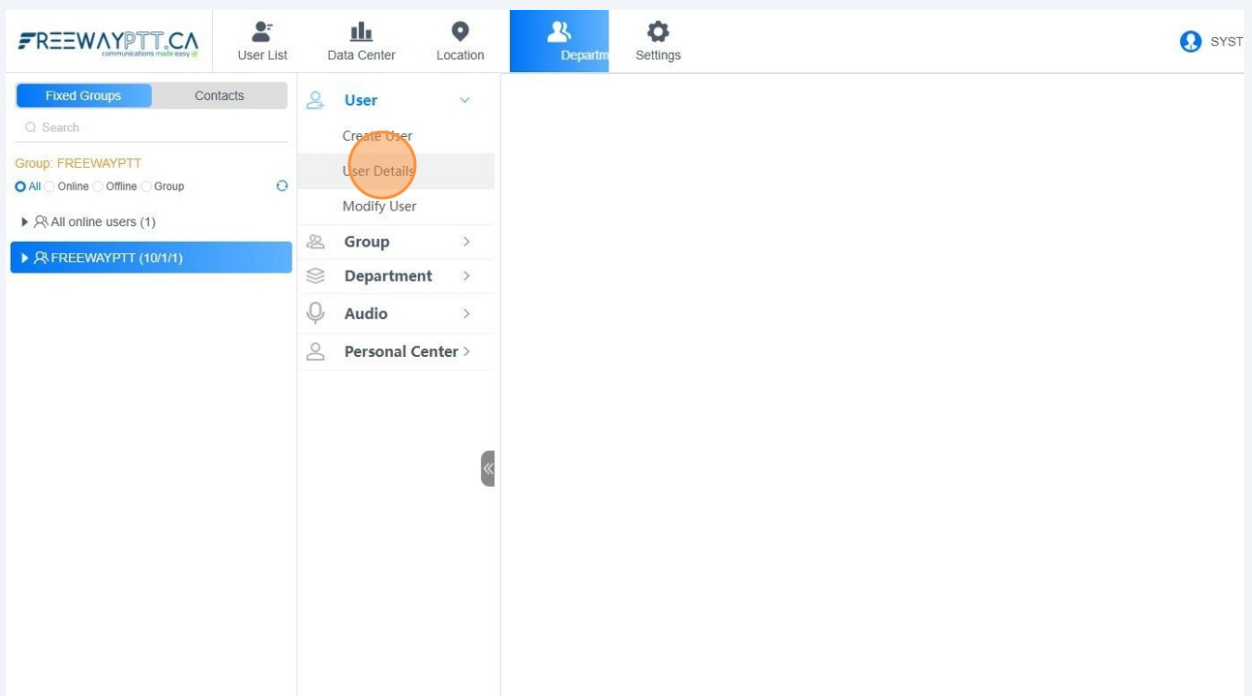
1 Click "Department Management"
