The following notes describe the recommended changes to the Contitution

3. MEMBERSHIP

In order to widen the Associations membership base we wish to open up our membership to include all persons who own a boat, or indeed maintain an interest in boating within the island of Jersey.

At present we have anomalies due to the fact that members may sell their boat but still wish to participate in boating.

We wish to ensure that persons who moor their boat in St Helier Harbours but reside outside of the island may join.

We have added a paragraph allowing us to revoke membership should that be necessary. We have added a paragraph regarding member resignation should they wish

We have removed the reference to Associate Membership as this is covered by the widened Eligible Member rule.

4. MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION

- 4a) We have added the office of Membership Secretary and therefor reduced the max committee to 7.
- 4b) We have added a paragraph stating that 2 committee members are required to allow expenditure.
- 4g) We have added a paragraph stating that committee members must be Eligible Members.
- 4i) We have tidied up the paragraph relating to video conferencing.
- 4j) We have included a paragraph relating to maintenance of register of Eligible Members
- 4k) We have included a paragraph relating to the keeping of minutes.

We have modified the paragraph by removing reference to the subscription amount in order that a change to subscription does not require a change to Constitution.
