Music without dance, yes, of course, that works. Dance without music: rarely in my view. This year's tanz_house festival bows to the music with short concerts that open the evenings to sharpen the ears and hearts for the performances that follow.

DOWNFALL — flashback

Am 5. November 1768 fällt mit Getöse ein Meteorit vom verdüsterten Himmel über Mauerkirchen. Die Bäuerin Apollonia Bart findet ihn anderntags. *DOWNFALL* lädt Gäste zuerst auf das Versuchsgelände von Lawine Torrèn nach Moosdorf ein, um einen tonnenschweren Stein in seinem Fall zu beobachten. Die seismische Erschütterung wird als Bodenchoreographie zu einem Film gefügt. Die performative Präsentation mitsamt Fels findet im SZENE Saal statt.

On November 5th, 1768, a meteorite falls with a roar from the darkened sky above Mauerkirchen. The farmer's wife Apollonia Bart finds it the next day. *DOWNFALL* first invites guests to the experimental site of Lawine Torrèn in Moosdorf to observe a stone weighing tons in its fall. The seismic shaking will be joined as a floor choreography to a film. The performative presentation including the rock takes place at SZENE Salzburg.

biographies

Banda Yala began as a duet, when Aron Hollinger (guitar) and Odysseas Manidakis (bouzouki) met, their goal back then was to play a few传统als and rembetiko tunes from Greece for fun. In 2018 Nikola Jelić (Akkordeon) joined in, bringing his own influence of Serbian folk music, soon composing own pieces. Through the recent addition of the enchanting voice of Karolína in 2022, the group was completed and entered a next stage.

Adrián Dozetas is an independent writer from Argentina based in Vienna. With a life on the search of new horizons, he dedicated it to arts in general and in particular to work based on words – pushing writing beyond its limits. Adrián published four books and collaborated in a variety of forms of performance poetry with different artists, recorded songs in collaboration with musicians and performers, and has written and directed plays. With *Written Portraits* he has traveled around the world, participating in major festivals.

Stefan Ebner is a contemporary songwriter and tells a lyrical and powerful story about emotional borderline situations and the difficulties of finding your way as a highly sensitive person.

Barbara Földesi – In her artistic work, the Salzburg dancer and choreographer Barbara Földesi engages in depth with movement research. The project *Circus/Tanz/Labor* emerged, a research laboratory for local artists. Further influences are her many years of studying Wing Tsun and her recent interest in contemporary circus.

Iris Heitzinger is a choreographer, dancer, teacher. Collaborates a.o. with Group LaBolsa, Thomas Hauert, Natalia Jiménez, Editta Braun, etc. Her choreographic work is based on an interest in collaborative processes, which has brought her together with people from music, science, acting and other disciplines. Her artistic aspirations are virtuosity in the context of live improvisation and composition in real time, as well as humor, lightness and touching depth.

Aron Hollinger is a multi-instrumentalist, composer and producer from Germany, educated as an Ensemble- and Choirleader, specified in Jazz/ Rock/Pop music in Munich, BA in Jazzguitar at the ABPU Linz, Austria, currently studies a Master in Ethnomusicology at the mdw in Vienna. Aron is performing various styles of music like Jazz, Rock, World Music, Traditional Music and improvised Music. A big interest of him is to work with musicians from different ethnic, musical and artistic Backgrounds.

Martin Kilvády was born in 1974 in Slovakia. In 1998 he received his Master of Arts. In 1997 he became a member of Anna Teresa de Keersmaeker's ROSAS. 2001–2004, he collaborated with Roberto Olivan. In the seasons 2002–2004, he worked with the circus company Rital Brocante. Since 2003, a member of Thomas Hauert's company ZOO. Martin Kilvády is co-founder of Les SlovaKs Collective. He has made more than 30 original creations and has been teaching for more than 25 years.

Lawine Torrèn is a network of artists directed by Hubert Lepka. Together, the dancers, actors, technicians, authors, media-artists, photographers, and musicians turn landscapes into stages for unprecedented performances. Like in film they handcraft significance by choreographic rearrangements of reality. A farm in Moosdorf close to Salzburg is their headquarter.

Andrea Lienbacher from Abtenau/Salzburg, started her musical education at the age of five at the Musikum Kuchl with diatonic harmonica. This was followed by, among other things, the piano, which is now her main instrument and she has been studying with Stan Ford at the University Mozarteum Salzburg since 2021. Apart from her extensive artistic activities, currently teaching at the Musikmittelschule Abtenau.

Maja Mirek born in Poland, journalist with BA degree, driven by the desire to heal the world. After an MA degree in Interactive Media, she changed her life and started dancing. In 2020 she completed her dance studies at the Royal Conservatory of Antwerp, now finalising her BA Dance Studies at the ABPU in Linz. Currently engaged at the Stadttheater Gießen. Beyond dance, Maja Mirek works as a photographer.

Birgit Mühlmann-Wieser trained at the Laban Centre London and the London Contemporary Dance School. 2005, founding the b.m-w dance company, since then, artistic director of the company, with a focus on psychological and socio-critical themes, experimental, intermedia collaborations, intensive exchange with internationally active choreographers, dramaturges and artists from other disciplines. For her artistic work, she received the best practice award in 2019 and the Teresa Lugstein Prize in 2021.

Was also engaged in opera productions at the Royal Opera House, English National Opera and the Barbican Centre. Rosana is the artistic director of the company Selva, co-founded with Verena Pircher in 2021.

Bernie Rothauer & Xandra/Heartgun – For over 30 years Bernie Rothauer has worked as an independent musician, has been on stage with many personalities and has dealt with West African, Afro-Brazilian as well as Afro-Cuban rhythm. Whether on guitar or drums, teaching or performing: tones, sounds, rhythms are part of his life. Xandra has been moving in the music wonderland for several years. The artistic work gives her the opportunity to work intensively, brightly and with all senses. Voice, hearing, body, mind – everything is needed, stressed, challenged.

Tomaž Simatović & András Meszerics are two performing artists based in Salzburg.
