As for "PUSH FOR MEGA MEDIA ATTENTION", nothing, it seems, has worked in Joseph's favor thus far. Good luck.

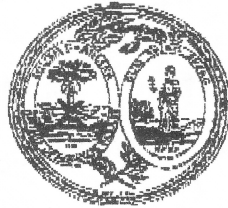
