
As to the next two paragraphs, I have nothing to respond to.

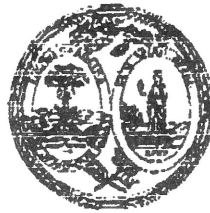

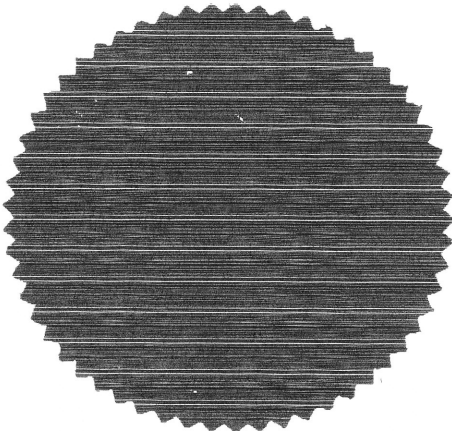


