Section 520.15(2) of the Criminal Procedure Law also requires that the person posting cash bail be advised :

- A. The person posting cash bail undertake that the defendant will appear in such action or proceeding whenever required and will, at all times, render himself amenable to the orders & processes of the court .
- B. THE CASH BAIL WILL BE FORFEITED IF THE PRINCIPAL DOES NOT COMPLY WITH ANY REQUIREMENT OR ORDER PROCESS TO APPEAR IN COURT .
- C. The money posted as cash bail remains the property of the person posting it unless forfeited to the court otherwise assigned .
- D. RETURN OF BAIL: When BAIL is ordered exonerated by the Court, an order will be filed with the Suffolk County Treasurer, Hauppauge, N.Y. . Upon receipt of court order said Treasurer will send the Depositor a check for return of bail, less 3% fee .
