It having been represented to me, **GEORGE E. PATAKI**, Governor of the State of New York, by the Governor of the Commonwealth of **Pennsylvania** that

JOSEPH CHARLES WAIKSNIS, AKA JOSEPH WAIKSNIS

is a fugitive from justice and stands convicted in that Commonwealth of the crime of **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Controlled Substance**, which the said Governor certifies to be a crime under the Laws of said Commonwealth, and that the accused was present in said Commonwealth at the time of the commission of the crime, and **failed to appear for service of sentence**, and thereafter fled therefrom and has taken refuge in the State of New York.

The said Governor of the demanding Commonwealth having, pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution, the Laws of the United States and the Laws of said Commonwealth, demanded that I, **GEORGE E. PATAKI**, Governor of the State of New York, cause the said accused to be arrested and delivered to **JOHN T. DAVIS AND/OR DULY DESIGNATED AGENT(S)** of the **Tioga County Sheriff's Department, Wellsboro, Pennsylvania** and/or **TransCor America, Inc., Nashville, Tennessee** duly authorized to receive, take into custody and convey the said accused back to the said demanding Commonwealth, which said demand is accompanied by a **Judgment, Sentence, Commitment Order and Capias**, duly certified by the Governor of the demanding Commonwealth to be authentic and duly authenticated, and charging the said accused with having been convicted of the said crime in the said demanding Commonwealth, having failed to appear for service of sentence, and having fled therefrom and taken refuge in the State of New York.

You are hereby required to arrest and secure the said accused wherever the said accused may be found within this State and after compliance with the requirements of the Uniform Criminal Extradition Act of the State of New York, to deliver the said accused into the custody of the said agent(s) to be taken back to the demanding Commonwealth, pursuant to the said requisition; and also to return this warrant, including a record of all the proceedings had hereunder, and all of the facts and circumstances relating thereto, to the Executive Chamber within thirty days from the date of final action hereon in said State.
