The Tampa Bay Aviation Association is excited to announce the opening of applications for the Girls Achieving Leadership in Aviation (GALA) Scholarship. This scholarship is dedicated to supporting young women in the Tampa Bay Area who are passionate about pursuing careers in the aviation industry. Whether you are just beginning your journey or already making strides in your aviation career, we encourage you to apply.

Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for the GALA Scholarship, you must:

- Be between the ages of 16 and 20 at the time of application
- Currently live or have a permanent address in the Tampa Bay Area*
- Have a keen interest in or currently pursuing a career in aviation

We welcome applications from those interested in the following fields:

- General Aviation Pilot Training
- Professional (Commercial) Pilot Training
- Aerospace Administration
- Airframe & Powerplant Mechanic
- Aerospace Engineering
- Aerospace Educator

Other career fields will be considered, so long as they are principally aviation related. Additionally, student pilots who are currently in-flight training for any certificate are strongly encouraged to apply.

Scholarship Details

Scholarships of up to \$10,000 each will be awarded. The number of scholarships and the amount awarded will depend on available funding, type of scholarships requested, and the number of qualified applicants.

Application Process

Applications will be considered that include the following required elements:

- The completed GALA Application Form
- Personal Statement Essay
- Recent hi-resolution class photo or passport photo (in color)
- Official Student Scholastic Record / Report
- List of school accomplishments
- Volunteer Hours / Community Service verification
- Two letters of recommendation from an instructor or employer (Dated within 30 days of application)

If applying for Flight Training Scholarships**, additional information is required. If applicable, please also include:

- Your flight school information (if training has begun)
- Copy of FAA Written Exam Report (REQUIRED)
- FAA Medical Certificate (if applicable)
- Copy of last page of logbook

The application window for the 2025 / 26 Fall / Winter scholarships is October 1st, 2025 - January 15th, 2026. Our committee will be conducting interviews with eligible candidates during the process and into February. Applicants selected as winners will be notified via email by March 1, 2026, and awards will be presented at the annual GALA fundraiser on Friday, March 13, 2026–a signature event celebrating aviation excellence and community impact
