

I. What is the fruit of the Spirit?

- A. It is one fruit, not many
 - Galatians 5:22
- B. It is something God does rather than you do
- 1) God's Spirit produces God's fruit (Galatians 5:16-18)
- 2) Contrast the "fruit" of the Spirit with the "acts" of the sinful nature (Galatians 5:19)
- C. It is the character of Jesus that God grows in you
