

Pressure Tank Instructions:

Pressure vessel air charge should be checked every 6-12 months, or if the pump has not been used for a prolonged period of time.

To check the pressure vessel air charge:

- 1. Turn off power to the pump.
- 2. Open nearest tap supplied by the pump until the water flow fades, keep tap open.
- 3. Unscrew the black plastic cover and apply an accurate gauge to the valve.
- 4. Vessel pressure should be at or close to 1 bar (14.5 psi)

To put air into the pressure vessel (if pressure is low or zero):

- 1. Attach pump or air compressor securely to the valve.
- 2. Add air to the vessel as necessary.
- 3. Monitor the pressure gauge and stop once desired pressure is reached.
- 4. Remove pump or compressor carefully to limit air loss.
- 5. Double check the pressure reading with a gauge and screw plastic cap back onto valve.
- 6. Close tap, turn on power to the pump.

Pressure should be adjusted to original pre-charge as follows:

Model	Pressure
HQ200_B	0.8 bar
HQ400_B	1 bar
HQ800_B	1 bar
