Uniform Standards

These guidelines are to create a consistent vision within the Group that all Youth members and leaders are guided by. This will also make it easier for youth members transitioning between sections.

Uniform is to be consistent with Scouts Australia policy.

All members must wear closed in shoes with socks at all Scout events.

Uniform standards for weekly meetings.

- Section shirt to be worn with all badges sewn on in the approved positions (See page
- In colder months a long sleeve garments may be worn under the shirt but must be navy or black.
- Group scarf with a woggle.
- Black, navy or beige/stone shorts or trousers/jeans. These must be visible below an untucked shirt. (School Shorts/Pants are fine)
- All footwear must be of the covered type. With a preference to Black or Brown shoes or boots but clean respectable footwear of other types is acceptable.

Uniform standards for Formal events.

- Formal events such as ANZAC day.
- Section shirt to be worn with all badges sewn on in the approved positions (See page 14).
- No long sleeve garments to be worn under the uniform.
- Black or Brown shoes / boots (no runners) must be clean.
- Black, navy or beige/stone pants (not tracksuits).
