



Resources to help spread the Gospel

Dear Ministry Partner,

Over the past year the publishing branch of our ministry, Publish2Day, has been helping CEF with printing of children's Sunday school materials and resources for training teachers so they can teach children.

Recently Kath (one of our team members) attended a CEF training session. She was excited to see how their materials were used to teach children the gospel message. She shared with us that it was especially rewarding to see how the materials we printed for them has enabled CEF to do their ministry in a more cost effective way.

Child Evangelism Fellowship - Thailand (CEF) is a Bible-centered organization composed of born-again believers whose purpose is to evangelize boys and girls with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and to establish (disciple) them in the Word of God and in the local church for Christian living.

Before using the services of Publish2Day, CEF had to order 500 to 1,000 items at a time and enter into a long-term contract with the printer to pay for their order.

Through Publish2Day CEF is now able to order just the number of resources needed for each training session.

This helps tremendously because they incur no extra cost, no debt and no inventory. They only order the amount they need at the time they are needed.

We are grateful we can come alongside ministries like this, to assist them with their needs as they train teachers to spread the gospel among children in all parts of Thailand.

Villages with no churches



Last month as I was analyzing the information in the Thailand Harvest Church Database I discovered a startling fact. **Out of the 80,677 villages in Thailand only 3,419 villages have a church, just 4% of the villages in the country.** This means that though the gospel has been in Thailand for 188 years the growth of the Thai church has occurred in just a few places. The gospel hasn't spread very far. **Another discovery is that if a village has a church there is a high probability the village has a second church.** Some villages have more than 10 churches.

What this tell me is when a village has a church people living there have a great opportunity to become a believer. **However, if a village has no church the people there have virtually no opportunity to become a follower of Jesus.** They have nowhere to worship God.

This new information has added a sense of urgency to my presentations over the past month. I have observed that as I share this new information it
