Advancement of the Gospel through Technology

We usually don't think about how technology has played a role in the advancement of the Gospel. By looking back through history we can see it has had an integral part. Here are a few examples:

Before the time of the Apostle Paul, the Romans built a system of roads which made it possible to move long distances at speed. These roads were built primarily for the military but also provided Christians the opportunity to spread the Gospel rapidly to distant parts of the empire.

In 1455, Johannes Gutenberg demonstrated a new printing technology allowing individuals to own copies of Scripture resulting in more people having access to God's Word. Wealthy individuals could purchase a Bible for the price equivalent to three years' wages. This was significantly cheaper than a handwritten Bible which would take a single monk 20 years to transcribe.

Sixty years ago Mission Aviation Fellowship started using airplanes to fly missionaries and national Christians to reach people in some of the most isolated parts of the world. Prior to the airplane, it would take days, if not weeks, to access these people groups. Now it only takes a few hours to reach them with the Gospel. As a result of this technology, thousands of individuals have come to know the Lord.

Since the 1980s, computer technology has dramatically changed the way Bible translators work. Consequently, the Bible is being translated faster and into more languages than previously thought possible. I like the perspective of a Bible translator I met earlier this year. He stated, "God created the computer for His work, everybody else just gets to use it."



With the rapid expansion of communication and computer technology worldwide, it only makes sense that it be used for Kingdom purposes. This is what we will be doing with MAF's Learning Technologies in SE Asia. Using the digital technologies available in each country, we will be applying it to teach Christians God's Word to reach the world with the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. It is clear that technology is God's gift to the Church - a resource to make it possible to fulfill the Great Commission.
