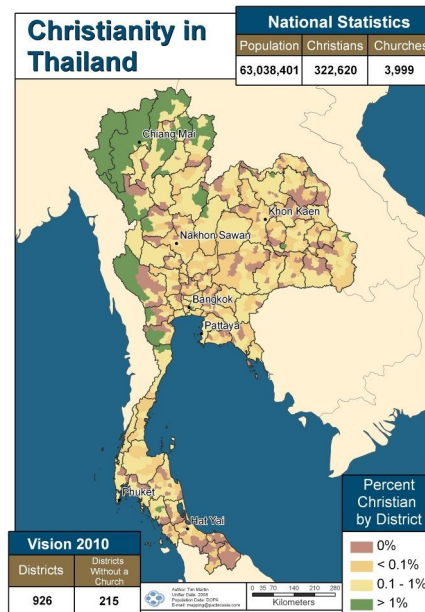

We also gave out thousands of CD's containing a library of 2,000 Thai Christian resources. These resources, for pastors, Sunday school teachers, worship leaders and others have greatly encouraged the Thai church. This CD provides Christian resources that are difficult to obtain or could not be afforded.

I was brought to tears during the opening night when I thought about my parents who served as missionaries in Thailand 30 to 60 years ago. They never had an opportunity to see an event like this. I wished so much they could be a part of it and see leaders they trained as young men and women
