Indoor Range Rules
Firearms & Archery

Failure to follow any rule may result in disciplinary action including suspension or expulsion from the FHFG Club.

1. Shooting has hazards, use range at your own risk.
2. No food or beverages allowed in range.
3. Members must sign the range logbook upon entering and leaving the range.
4. Only one guest allowed per member, guest must sign logbook when entering and exiting and must exit with the member.
5. No shooter 18 or younger may use the range facilities without adult supervision.
6. If multiple shooters, appoint a "range control" officer. Range officer(s) have final say on all issues
7. Firearms and bows must be brought in unloaded.
8. Crossbows are not permitted indoors.
9. Firearms to be chambered at the firing line only when ready to fire. No more than 2 firearms at a shooting station.
10. All firearms when not in use shall be unloaded, slides locked back, bolts or cylinders opened with empty chamber indicators (ECI) in place and magazines out. No one is allowed downrange until these actions are taken and the range is declared safe.
11. Arrows are to be only loaded at the firing line, bows are not to be taken downrange of the shooting line.
12. Only legitimate pistol calibers allowed.
13. Only .22 caliber rifles allowed.
14. No shotguns are allowed.
15. Only archery field and target points permitted, no hunting points
16. Archers should stand to side of arrow when removing arrows from backstops/blocks, not behind. If a top and bottom target are used, top arrows are to be pulled first.
17. Possible lead hazard, exhaust fans must be used for all firearm shooting.
18. Ear and eye protection must always be worn for firearm shooting.

19. All New York state firearm laws must be complied with.
20. All shooting must be from shooting stations.
21. Shoot in your lane only; no side or cross shooting allowed.
22. No firearms or bows are to be carried past the firing line, down range.
23. Only paper targets are to be used. No human like targets or silhouettes to be used.
24. Targets are to be properly positioned with back stop in shooter's line of sight
25. Use approved target holders. Do not use archery back stops for firearm targets.
26. No cowboy shooting allowed. No quick draw shooting.
27. No holstered drawing.
28. No rapid firing is permitted. There is to be a mandatory delay (defined as: The time it takes to re-acquire the target at which you are shooting between fired rounds.)
29. FHFGC rules prevail in all situations (such as shooting leagues or any competition matches)
30. Clean up and dispose of all trash in the proper receptacles.
31. Dispose of any "live rounds" in designated containers.
32. File Incident Reports if required in timely manner.
