- Please complete the front and back sections of the form and initial next to the relevant activities.

- Children must please excuse themselves if not able to attend an extramural session. Children who attend extramurals regularly will earn points for their houses.
- Children who are not involved in an extramural activity on any given day need to be collected at home time. There is no supervision for children not collected on time.
- Grade 0-2 children doing an extramural need to do an integrated day activity (13:15 – 13:45).
- No additional cost is incurred for any Integrated Day activities or first session extramurals (14:00-15:00), Monday to Thursday (unless indicated as a private activity).
- **Private activities are an arrangement between yourself and the organisers. PPS only facilitates a venue for the activity.**

EXTRAMURAL BEHAVIOUR STRATEGY:

As per the school behaviour policy, behaviour is encouraged positively. Should further action be required the following steps will be followed:

1. Encouragement and warnings given by extramural teacher;
2. Child sent to Extramural Coordinator where a reminder of appropriate behaviour is given; **IF PROBLEMS PERSIST**
3. Child discusses behaviour with the Extramural Coordinator discussing more appropriate choices of behaviour, a first warning is issued (parents emailed);
4. On continuation of the behaviour to the point that the activity cannot continue in any given session, the Extramural Coordinator will discuss a one week time-out from the extramural and a 2nd warning is given;
5. On the 3rd intervention by the extramural coordinator, the child is asked to leave extramurals for the remainder of the term (parents emailed). They will be welcomed back in the following term.

Children are asked to wear or bring their takkies and stipulated sport clothing requirements on the days they participate in any sport related activity.

do. Such a decision will be made on the clear understanding that the person providing the necessary
consent is acting *in loco parentis* and acting as a responsible parent in giving the approval.

Notwithstanding the above provisions, approval of this Notification of Indemnity does not in any
way remove or deny the learner or parent(s)/guardian(s) those safeguards which are afforded

according to the laws of South Africa, under whose jurisdiction, to the exclusion of all others, this Indemnity pertains.

I, the parent/guardian, shall be responsible for the payment of any medical and / or hospital accounts, where applicable should an injury or illness be sustained for which ever reason.
