FEE STRUCTURE 2026

The Board of Directors have finalized the school's budget for next year and the annual tuition fee increases. As in the past, this has been a thorough process involving the analysis of all our school's financial needs. This increase is unavoidable if we are to retain and acquire our qualified and experienced staff members, maintain and improve our school facilities, continue to keep abreast of educational developments, provide our children with the specialised attention and equipment they need, and to deliver on our promise of excellence in remedial education.

Fees for 2026 will be as follows:

Grade 0 – 7: R135 850 per annum. Fees will be charged over 11 months @ R12 350.00 per month from January to November 2026, and are payable in advance before the 6th of every month.

These fees are fully inclusive of all Speech and Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Remedial Lessons during the course of the school day as well as an Extramural (first session) charge.

School fees paid in full before the end of February 2026 will receive a 3% deduction, and the calculation of the reduced annual fees payable is as follows:

Grade 0 – 7: R135 850 – R 4 075 = R131 775.

Should school fees be paid in full for 2026 by 30 November 2025, an additional 1% discount is offered, an additional R1 320. The amount due if paid before 30 November 2025 would be R130 455.

Application can be made to SARS for a partial rebate on school fees when completing your income tax form on e-filing. Please request the tax certificate from the Bursar from March 2026. The SARS disability form is valid up to ten years however, should you require an updated document, please request this from your medical practitioner.

Thank you very much to each and every parent who pays school fees regularly every month. You make our administration so much more efficient and our school more productive. We are looking forward to your continued support in 2026 and trust it will be a happy and successful year.
