ARRL NEWS

2024 Field Day Results: VCARC Did Well!

The ARRL 2024 Field Day results were recently published. The VCARC did well, placing in the middle of the pack in the 5A category with 2580 total points.

Category 5A (Number of Bands, Club) had a total of 81 entries operating on non-commercial power.

The VCARC was one of only three Wisconsin Field Day stations operating in the 5A category.

The 2025 ARRL Field Day is set for the weekend of June 28 and 29. Let's make 2025 a record year!

All 85 ARRL and Radio Amateurs of Canada (RAC) Sections participated in Field Day, and we received 64 entries from 27 countries outside the US and Canada, which is a record high for DX participation in this event.

The total number of reported QSOs increased by 4% to almost 1.3 million, likely attributed to increased propagation as we near the peak of Solar Cycle 25. The number of phone and CW contacts increased from last year, with more than 522,000 phone contacts and more than 490,000 CW contacts. More than 283,000 digital QSOs were reported this year, which is a slight decrease from last year.

ARRL 160 Meter Contest CW

Contest Objective: For Amateurs worldwide to exchange information with W/VE amateurs on 160-meter CW.

Contest Period: December 6-8, 2024. Begins at 2200 UTC Friday, ends 1559 UTC Sunday. This is a forty-two-hour period with no time limitation.

SKYWARNTM (Special Event)

Recognition Day is December 7, 2024. The annual event is celebrating its 25th anniversary.

There will be an SRD special event from 0000 - 2359 UTC on the day. The objective is for all amateur stations to exchange QSO information with as many Amateur Radio SKYWARN Spotters and National Weather Service Stations as possible on the 80, 40, 20, 15, 10, 6, 2-meter and 70-centimeter bands.

ARRL 10 Meter Contest

Objective: For Amateurs worldwide to exchange QSO information with as many stations as possible on the 10-meter band.

Contest Period: December 14-15, 2024.Starts 0000 UTC Saturday; runs through 2359 UTC Sunday.

ARRL Straight Key Night (Special Event)

Objective: This 24-hour event is not a contest; rather it is a day dedicated to celebrating our CW heritage. The use of straight keys or bugs to send CW is preferred. Everyone who participates is a winner!

Event Period: January 1 from 0000 UTC through 2359 UTC.




TECH TALK


WiRES X Presentation Part 1

Kyle AB9AX gave an excellent presentation on Wires X at the VCARC November meeting. The following is a summary of the presentation.

WiRES-X is the software that networks the System Fusion nodes together on the internet. WiRES X utilizes Yaesu's digital mode C4FM or System Fusion which enables digital access to repeaters.

Examples of a WiRES X setup:





To use WiRES X, you will need:

- a C4FM capable radio to access a C4FM repeater (DR-2X).
- Find an access point Node, tune to its frequency and access WiRES X.
- Obtain a personal node number through Yaesu to utilize WiRES X.
- Have a hotspot (e.g. Zumspot) and use software like PiStar which allows Fusion access with non C4FM radios.

Modes on C4FM Radios:

 Auto: The TX and RX are automatically selected based on the mode of the signal received (AMS). Options: DN, VW, DW, and FM On the radio the mode will be depicted by a bar over it. Manual: The TX and RX are manually selected from the options of DN, VW, DW, and FM. There will be no bar over it as the indicator.

When using C4FM on repeaters, you need to be in DN mode. If you are an analog user and don't want to hear the C4FM tones, set the PL tone for both RX and TX.
