- Tech Talk was about batteries and building them.
- There was a video presentation and a building of a battery.

- When batteries are new, they should show that they are over their Amp hour rating.
- Batteries should not be very bloated at all.
- Batteries can be compressed, which helps for the extra gas to escape, but not a real tight compression.
- Charging temps for batteries is: 33 degrees to 120 degrees Fahrenheit.
- Discharging temps for batteries is: -4 degrees to 140 degrees
 Fahrenheit.
- Batteries can be charged while in use.
