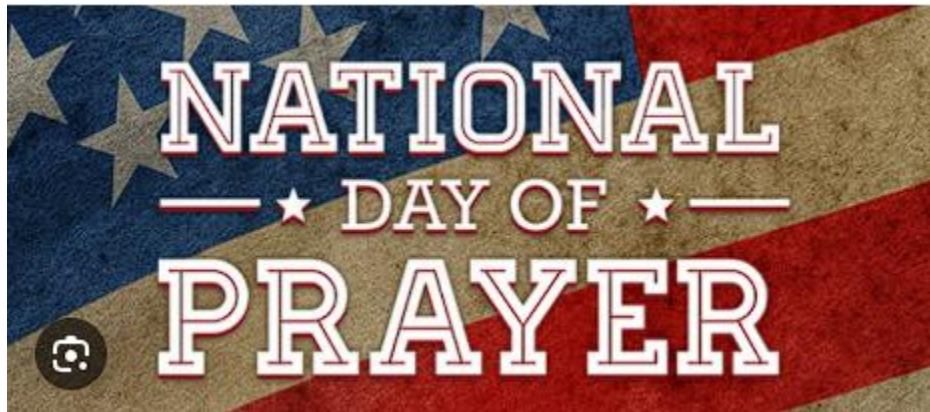


Join Us On The National Day of Prayer
