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Annex 1 GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Scope of application

These terms and conditions apply to all contracts for theoretical and practical training, as well as other training and further education events provided by Vector Aero GmbH (hereinafter: Vector Aero) and its contractual partners. This also includes training materials for self-study and media provided by Vector Aero GmbH and its contractual partners.

2. Contractual services

2.1. By ticking the examination of my choice, I am applying for the examination(s) in a binding manner. The Vector Aero will accept the application as long as a signed contract is available. The contract becomes effective upon confirmation of application by the Vector Aero. If the number of applications is too low or for other significant reasons, advertised examinations may be cancelled. Participants will be promptly informed in the event of course cancellation. Claims for damages are excluded.

2.2. Examinations are generally scheduled Monday through Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

2.3. Vector Aero conducts examination(s) on behalf of Q.C.M Quality Control Management AG, an approved EASA Part-147, CH.147.0012 training and examination organization and commits to examining the participant in accordance with EASA Part-66 and Part-147 requirements.

2.4. The Vector Aero will provide the examination participant with a certificate in accordance with EASA Part-147 issued by Q.C.M Quality Control Management AG, CH.147.0012.

3. Term of the contract

The contract will end on the day of the applied module examination(s) unless effective notice of termination is provided in advance. This does not affect the payment obligation. The participant's obligations during the contract period will not be affected if the applicant misses the examination.

4. Termination of the contract

The participant can terminate the contract at any time up to 5 working days before the start of the examination, free of charge, and must always do so in writing. Other termination is only possible with good cause as defined under § 626 German Civil Code (BGB). The terminating party must immediately inform the other party of the reason for termination in writing upon request. In all cases of extraordinary termination, the applied module examination costs must be paid. The obligation of Vector Aero to provide examination will cease (and thereby justify termination by Vector Aero in accordance with § 626 German Civil Code (BGB) if further participation in the re-scheduled examination becomes impossible.

This is assumed, among other things, in the event of criminal offences against Vector Aero, the invigilators, examiners, or fellow examinees, as well as in case of a significant violation of the examination conditions. The application of § 627 German Civil Code (BGB) is excluded for both contractual partners.

5. Examinations, re-examinations

The module examination fees are described in Annex 2 to this form. If the examination is unsuccessful, a re-examination can be taken at the same fee after 90 days, which is in line with (EU) No 1321/2014 regulation. A separate contractual agreement is required for a re-examination. If the third examination is unsuccessful, a new examination can only take place after one year in accordance with EASA Part-66 Annex III, Appendix II, 1.13.

6. Data protection & exchange of paper forms

Please submit all forms (proof of absence, application forms, etc.) to the Vector Aero main office. If you prefer your data to remain anonymous, kindly hand in all documents to be processed in an opaque envelope marked with your full name. You will receive processed documents in the same envelope. If we receive open documents for processing (without a folder/envelope), it will be understood that you also want to receive your documents back (possibly for third parties to see). Personal data will be stored purely for Maintenance Training Organization-related purposes in accordance with §5 of the German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG) and will not be shared with third parties without authorization. By signing this contract, the participant agrees to the data protection clause.

7. Miscellaneous

The place of performance and jurisdiction for this agreement is Leipzig. There are no additional agreements to this, and any changes to the contract must be made in writing to be legally effective. Also, any waiver of the requirement for written form must be made in writing. The termination of this agreement also requires a written form.

If any provisions of this agreement are or become invalid, it will not affect the validity of the remaining provisions. A corresponding invalid clause will be replaced by one that serves the purpose of the original provision; the same applies in the event of a loophole.

8. Eating, Drinking, and Smoking in the Classrooms

Please handle the rooms and furniture with care. Food and drinks from non-closable containers are not allowed at Classrooms. Smoking is prohibited in all areas of our training premises, including the stairwell at entrance area. Vector Aero GmbH is not liable for lost items, or belongings left behind.

9. Audio and Video Recordings

No audio or video recordings or photographs of examination content are permitted.

Withdrawal Policy

You have the right to withdraw from this contract within two weeks without giving any reason. The withdrawal period is two weeks from the day you sign this form. To exercise your right of withdrawal, you must inform us of your decision to withdraw this application by means of a clear declaration (e.g. a letter sent by post, fax, or e-mail). To comply with the withdrawal period, it is sufficient for you to send the notification of the exercise of the right of withdrawal before the expiry of the withdrawal period. However, the contract cannot be withdrawn within 5 working days prior to the start of the examination.
