



Aftercare Guide for Your New Tattoo Congratulations on your new tattoo! To ensure optimal healing and keep your tattoo looking great, follow these aftercare steps:

- 1. Maintain the Bandage Wear Time: Keep the bandage (or wrap) on for the first 2-4 hours after you get your tattoo. Change: If the bandage becomes dirty or soaked with blood and ink, carefully change it for a new one.
- 2. Initial Cleaning Time: After removing the bandage, wash the tattoo area with warm water and a mild, unscented soap. Use clean hands, not a sponge. Drying: Pat the tattoo dry with a clean, soft towel. Do not rub or scratch.
- 3. Cream Application Type: Use a tattoo-specific cream or fragrance-free moisturizer. Avoid using products that contain alcohol, as they can dry out the skin. Frequency: Apply a thin layer of moisturizer 2-3 times a day for the first 2 weeks.
- 4. Avoid Water and Sun: Do not immerse the tattoo in water (pools, sea, bathtubs) for at least 2 weeks or expose it directly to the su. Apply sunscreen after 3-4 week. If you use a menbrane, you can enjoy the beachand pool without worries. We work with menbranes!

- 5. Clothing and Friction Clothing: Wear loose clothing over the tattooed area to avoid friction and allow the skin to breathe. Avoid: Do not scratch or remove scabs. This can affect the design and cause scarring.
- 6. Normal Symptoms and When to Seek Help Normal: Redness, swelling and mild itching are common in the first few days. Unusual: If you experience severe pain, pus, fever, or an allergic reaction, contact your tattoo artist or a medical professional.
- 7. Continuing Care Moisturizing: Continue to moisturize the tattoo with a mild cream for a few weeks, even after the healing process has finished.
- 8. Reviews Tattoo Artist: If you have any questions or concerns about the healing process, do not hesitate to contact your tattoo artist for a review.
