

1           A.    Yes.  I did.  I contacted the judge --  
2           the judge's office who signed the PFA and I just  
3           wanted to get a little bit of background behind  
4           this.  I was given the history between the  
5           plaintiff --

6                     Mr. MacIntyre:  Objection.  Hearsay.

7           By Mr. Hearn:

8           Q.    Okay.  You don't need to testify as to  
9           what she told you or what the office told you.

10          A.    I was just saying I got the history.

11          Q.    Okay.  Did you make other calls?

12          A.    Yes.  I did.

13          Q.    What other call did you make?

14          A.    I contacted Ms. Brush's attorney or her  
15          attorney's office, which I was told that it was  
16          -- I have it listed in my report here -- Jen  
17          Bierly's office who represented Ms. Brush.

18          Q.    Why did you call Jen Bierly's office?

19          A.    Probably right when I got off the phone  
20          with the judge's office.

21          Q.    No.  I mean why?

22          A.    Why?  I was concerned.  I was concerned  
23          why somebody would drive the whole way from  
24          Wisconsin to Centre County, Pennsylvania to try  
25          to have their ex arrested.

1 Q. Had you ever made a call like that  
2 before?

3 A. In my 17 years of law enforcement I have  
4 never did that before. We have never sent other  
5 officers out to get plate number off this vehicle  
6 and maybe keep an eye for it throughout the next  
7 couple days.

8 Q. What was your sense of his state of  
9 mind?

10 A. The only way I could put it was just  
11 something seemed off. You know, I talk to people  
12 every day. I deal with thousands of people out  
13 of the year and for something to seem off to me  
14 it has -- there is something there. I have never  
15 really talked to anybody to where like after I  
16 answered their question and they just kind of  
17 looked at me like they are trying to see into me  
18 and like read me and see, you know, if I am going  
19 to flinch. I have never had that as a police  
20 officer other than somebody who is about ready to  
21 attack me but I am not saying that Mr. Feldman  
22 was going to attack me. It's just I was getting  
23 kind of a read like that. Just kind of a creepy  
24 vibe.

25 Q. Were you concerned about Ms. Brush's

1 safety after --

2 A. Absolutely. Absolutely. To the point  
3 where I had to contact her attorney's office and  
4 then I did make contact with Ms. Brush and just  
5 wanted to get her side of everything and find out  
6 what her feelings were on everything and why he  
7 may be in the area.

8 Q. So when you talked to Ms. Brush what did  
9 you tell her?

10 A. I just said, you know, we had somebody  
11 come into the office today and I talked to the  
12 District Attorney about this and that. Just gave  
13 her ins and outs of what was said during that  
14 day. She was terrified. She was absolutely  
15 terrified. She was worried he was in Centre  
16 County, he is here to get me, he is here to find  
17 out where I am at and he is going to get me.

18 Q. Thank you, officer. I have no other  
19 questions.

22 By Mr. MacIntyre:

23 Q. Did you read the documents he gave you  
24 or did you just glance through them?

25 A. I did not. They were this thick and I

17       behavior on the part of Mr. Feldman that has led  
18       you to be concerned about your safety?

19              A.   Well we just heard some of the things  
20       from kind of going backwards I guess.   There was  
21       what the officer said, Officer Walter.   That  
22       particular event resulted in me and my daughter  
23       basically going into hiding for about two and a  
24       half days because nobody knew where Leland was.  
25       I get this panicked phone call from my attorney's

1 office and they are telling me to check in with  
2 my local police station, the officer in  
3 Bellefonte is concerned about my safety. So I  
4 take my daughter to the police station. We tell  
5 them what happened. I talked to my attorney and  
6 asked where is he, is he coming to look for us in  
7 Maryland, what is he up to, can you contact Mark  
8 Weaver, and nothing. She said she kept trying to  
9 call him. I don't think -- who knows what  
10 happened behind the scene there. I don't know.  
11 But all I know is that the effect of it was we  
12 were basically panicked and in hiding for about  
13 two and a half days before we finally found that,  
14 okay, he is back in Wisconsin now, like everybody  
15 take a breath. That's one event.

16 Another event that stands out in my mind  
17 very similar to this -- another one of his former  
18 attorneys, Raquel Ross, in a very similar  
19 situation at one time -- she had been  
20 representing him for a while. I guess she had  
21 some deep concerns about --

22 Mr. MacIntyre: Objection.

23 The Witness: -- his sanity.

24 Mr. Hearn: Hold on. Hold on.

25 The Court: Sustained.
