A tax rate of \$0.23210 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of West Wharton County Hospital District.

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2025 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for West Wharton County Hospital District from the same properties in both the 2024 tax year and the 2025 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that West Wharton County Hospital District may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that West Wharton County Hospital District is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2025 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 22, 2025 AT 11:30 am AT El Campo Memorial Hospital conference room.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, West Wharton County Hospital District is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Board of Directors of West Wharton County Hospital District at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.
